## Marine Notice No. 3 of 2018

## Application for the endorsement of a foreign Certificate of Competency.

TO ALL SEAFARERS, SHIP OWNERS, SHIP OPERATORS, CREWING MANAGERS, EXAMINERS, PRINCIPAL OFFICERS AND EDUCATION AND TRAINING INSTITUTIONS

Marine Notice No. 15 of 2015 is cancelled

## Summary

This Marine Notice updates the procedures to be followed by candidates when applying to have their Certificate of Competency to be recognised for serving on board a South African ship and the issue of the endorsement thereof.

- 1. Section 83 of the Merchant Shipping Act permits the employment of a holder of a foreign certificate of competency on a South African ship provided the holder is authorised by Regulations
- 2. The Merchant Shipping (Safe Manning, Training and Certification) Regulations, 2013, as amended (the Regulations) provides the principles for the South African Maritime Safety Authority (SAMSA) to follow when accepting a foreign certificate of competency.
- 3. Individual seafarers may submit their applications to their nearest Port Office.
- 4. Employers applying on behalf of seafarers must direct their applications to the Office of the Chief Examiner through e-mail to <a href="mailto:cecapplications@samsa.org.za">cecapplications@samsa.org.za</a> where the applications shall be dealt with.
